What You Needed

- Iron with steam feature
- Ironing board
- Spray bottle with water
- Clean cloth (optional, if necessary)

Steps to Iron Your LUXCover® School Uniform

1. Read the Care Label:

Check the school uniform care label for specific ironing instructions, including temperature settings.

2. Set Up the Ironing Board:

Place the ironing board in a comfortable spot. Ensure it is stable and at a height that is easy for you to work with.

3. Heat the Iron:

Plug in the iron and set it to medium to high temperature with a steam feature.

4. Dampen the Fabric:

If the uniform is very wrinkled, lightly spray it with water using a spray bottle. This helps to relax the fibers.

5. Start with the Shirt:

- Collar: Iron the collar first, starting from the points and moving to the center.
- **Cuffs**: Iron the cuffs next, opening them up for a flat surface.
- **Body**: Lay the shirt flat on the board. Start with the back, then the front. Move the iron smoothly from the top to the bottom.
- Always Spray with Water: This helps to smooth and relax the fabric.

6. Use a Clean Cloth on Top if Necessary:

Place a clean cloth over the area before ironing to prevent burns.

Spray water on the fabric to increase the amount of steam and make the ironing process smoother.

7. Final Touches:

Check for any missed wrinkles and touch them up. Hang the uniform immediately after ironing to prevent new wrinkles from forming.

8. Cool Down:

Allow the uniform to cool before folding or putting it on to maintain its crispness.



- ★ Always keep the iron moving to prevent scorching.
- **TIPS** ★ Use steam if your iron has this feature; it helps to remove stubborn wrinkles.
 - ★ Always spray with water, it helps to smooth and relax the fabric.
